



OUR RULES

Be safe.

Students will work safely.

- Students keep their hands, feet and body to themselves.
- Students use learning tools appropriately.

Students will play safely.

- Students keep their hands, feet and body to themselves.
- Students will remain in sight of yard duty at all times.

Students will eat safely.

- Students will remain seated while eating.
- No running or walking while eating.
- Students will not share food due to food allergies.

Students will dress safely.

- Students will wear secure shoes daily for playground and P.E.
- Shoes must have secure backs. No flip flops, slides, or shoes with wheels or heels.

Be respectful.

Students will speak respectfully to adults and peers.

- No foul/disrespectful language permitted.

Students will respectfully follow our school dress code.

- No hats may be worn in class.
- No bare midriffs allowed at school.
- No overly ripped shirts or clothing with inappropriate themes.

Be responsible.

Students will use classrooms, common areas, and restrooms responsibly.

- Students are not allowed in classrooms without adult supervision.
- Students will not play in restrooms.
- Students will keep restrooms clean.

Students will be responsible and keep campus clean and tidy.

- No littering.
- Pick up stray trash to pitch in for our school community.
- Walk on pathways, not on plants.
- Students will not damage school property (books, desks, buildings, laptops, etc.)

PLAYGROUND RULES

Playground rules are for student safety before school and during school hours.

- No balls, equipment, toys or electronic devices are allowed on the yard during school hours. No balls are used on the yard in the morning before school starts.
- Students must stay seated while eating in supervised lunch areas. No running or walking while eating.
- Students may go to the office only when given permission by yard supervisors.
- Students must ask permission to use the restroom or to leave the playground. Students are not to play in and around the bathrooms.
- Tackle football or other tackling activities are not permitted.
- Children are not to climb trees or fences, or play in the bushes.
- While using slides, students must go DOWN the slide, one at a time. Students must sit down while sliding. Students may not climb up the slide.
- No tag games on or around the play structure.
- No tying the jump ropes.
- No standing on, twisting, or jumping off the swings. Students count the times they see a child's shoe soles - to 30 on Kinder yard, or 100 on Main Yard – until it is the next person's turn on the swing.
- To avoid collisions, no riding bikes, scooters, Heelies or skateboards on the school grounds (unless previously approved by a teacher or administrator). Please walk bikes to the bike racks.
- Unless cleared by the teacher/administration, no gum is allowed.
- Children should freeze when a teacher blows the whistle or when the bell rings. Two tweets of the whistle means that students unfreeze and walk to class.
- During school hours, yard usage is for Laurel students and staff only.
